

The East African Monetary Union (EAMU) Protocol was signed on 30th November 2013 with its main objective of having a single currency for all the Partner States within the EAC region

To have a single currency, Article 5 of the EAMU Protocol requires Partner States to attain the following three (3) indicative macroeconomic convergence criteria namely:



In addition, EAMU requires Partner States to attain and maintain macroeconomic convergence for at least three consecutive years that shall be assessed on the following four (4) performance criteria:





In the run-up for achieving a single currency, the EAC Partner States aim to harmonise statistics among others policies and standards. The EAC secretariat is working towards harmonisation of statistics and is pleased to present the third quarterly Statistics Bulletin on International Merchandise Trade Statistics (IMTS) and the EAC Harmonised Consumer Price Index (HCPI).



It is to provide summary data on HCPI and International Trade Statistics for policy makers, researchers and other users at the national, regional and international levels.

The data used in the Bulletin is provided by the National Statistics Offices (NSOs) of the EAC Partner States. NSOs submit the data to the EAC Secretariat on a monthly basis and the data can be accessed through https://eac.opendataforafrica.org.



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EAC HARMONISED CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (EAC-HCPI)

1.0 Introduction


The Harmonised Consumer Price Index (HCPI) from the Partner States are compiled using common methodologies. The EAC-HCPIs are aggregated from the HCPIs submitted by the six out of the eight EAC Partner States namely Republics of Burundi, Kenya, Rwanda, Uganda, South Sudan and the United Republic of Tanzania.

National CPIs for the DRC and the Federal Republic of Somalia are not included as they were not members of the EAC during the setting up of the system for the EAC-HCPI compilation.

However, plans are underway for their inclusion. The regional EAC-HCPI is computed as a weighted average of the HCPIs submitted by the six Partner States. The weights were derived as a proportion of the GDP for each of the six Partner States. The current EAC-HCPI has a reference period of 2016/17 Fiscal Year (July 2016 to June 2017).

The HCPI submitted by the Partner States are classified using the recent international standards of classification of goods and services for household final consumption referred to as Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP- 2018).

In addition, classification was also done for specific product categories based on the EAC regional specific needs. The HCPI can be revised when improved data become available. Any changes will be communicated in the next publication.



The EAC-Headline inflation is a price change derived from the EAC-HCPI which is an aggregated index comprised of all goods and services of the National CPI Baskets of the EAC Region. The EAC-HCPI is computed as a weighted average of the national CPI of the participating Partner States.

The Annual Headline (Year-on-year) Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the EAC-HCPI stood at 5.4% in December 2023, and it was 6.7% in December 2022.

The month-on-month Headline Inflation in the EAC region stood at minus 0.4% for the month of December 2023, down from 0.2% registered in November 2023. It was minus 0.7% in December 2022 (Table 1.5).

The Annual Average Headline Inflation

The Annual Average Headline Inflation for the 2023 Calendar Year was at 6.3% up from 5.5% recorded for the 2022 Calendar year. The increase is mainly due to increase in inflation that was registered for the Republic of Burundi.



The Annual Average Headline Inflation for 2022/23 Fiscal Year stood at 7.2% up from 4.2% that was recorded for the 2021/22 Fiscal year.

This big increase was due to increases that were registered for the Republics of Burundi, Rwanda and Uganda (Table 1.13).



1.2 EAC Regional Core Inflation

The Core (underlying) Inflation is a price change derived from the HCPI by excluding products whose price movements are transient or volatile.


The Annual Core (Underlying) Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the EAC-HCPI stood at 3.7% in December 2023. A year earlier, the rate was 6.9% in December 2022.

The Annual Average Core Inflation

The Annual Average Core (underlying) Inflation in the EAC region was 5.5% for the 2023 Calendar Year up from 4.9% recorded for the 2022 Calendar year.



1.2.1. EAC Regional Services Inflation

Service products referred to are: Actual Rentals for Housing; Maintenance, Repair and Security of the Dwelling; Health Services; Transport; Information; Communication; Recreation; Sport; Culture; Education Services; Restaurants and Accommodation Services; Insurance and Financial Services; Personal Care and Social Protection services among others. Thus, Inflation under this category measure price changes of the above listed product categories.:

The Annual Services Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the EAC-HCPI stood at 3.8% for the month of December 2023. It was at 4.4% in November 2023 and 2.4% in December, 2022.

The month-on-month Services Inflation stood at 0.1% for the month of December 2023, up from minus 0.1 % which was registered in November 2023. It was 0.7 % in December 2022.

The Annual Average Services Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the Harmonized Consumer Price Index (EAC-HCPI) was 4.3% for 2023 Calendar Year up from 1.7% recorded for the 2022 Calendar year. The annual average Services Inflation was 2.8% for 2022/23 Fiscal Year up from 2.4% that was recorded for 2021/22.



1.2.2. EAC Regional Other Goods Inflation

Products referred to are processed foods and all other manufactured goods except Energy products, Fuel products and Utilities.

The Annual Other Goods Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the EAC-HCPI stood at 4.5% for month of December 2023. It was at 3.3% in November 2023 and 7.0% in December, 2022.

The month-on-month Other Goods Inflation stood at minus 0.6% for the month of December 2023, down from 0.1 % which was registered in November 2023. It was minus 1.7 % in December 2022.



The Annual Average Other Goods Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the EAC-HCPI was 5.5% for Calendar Year 2023 down from 6.4% recorded for the 2022 Calendar year. The annual average Other Goods Inflation was 7.7% for Fiscal Year 2022/23 up from 4.7% that was recorded for 2021/22

1.3 EAC Regional Non Core Inflation

Non-Core inflation is a price change derived from the HCPI after excluding all products that are used to measure the Core (Underlying) Inflation.

The derived HCPI includes prices of the following products:



The Annual Non-Core Inflation for the EAC region as measured by the EAC-HCPI stood at 11.2% for the month of December 2023, up from 7.9% registered in November 2023. A year earlier, in December 2022, the rate was 6.5%.

The month-on-month Non-Core Inflation in the EAC region stood at minus 0.8% for the month of December 2023, down from 0.4% which was registered in November 2023. It was minus 3.7% in December 2022.



The Annual Average Non-Core Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the EAC- HCPI was 9.2% for 2023 Calendar Year up from 7.8% recorded for 2022 Calendar year. While the annual Average Non-Core Inflation was 9.4% for 2022/23 Fiscal Year up from 6.8% that was recorded for 2021/22.

1.3.1 EAC Regional Food Crops and related **Products Inflation**

Prices of Food Crops and related Products includes prices of the following products: food crops; fresh milk sold loose; and tobacco leaves. Thus, Inflation under this category measures price changes of the above listed product categories.

The Annual Food Crops and related Products Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the EAC-HCPI stood at 10.4% in December 2023. A year earlier, in December 2022, the rate was 3.1%

The month-on-month Food Crops and related Products Inflation stood at minus 1.3% in December 2023, down from 0.4 % which was registered in November 2023. It was minus 6.4 % in December 2022.



The Annual Average Food Crops and related Products Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the EAC-HCPI was 7.3% for the 2023 Calendar year up from 6.9% recorded for the 2022 Calendar year. It was 7.9% for the 2022/23 Fiscal Year up from 6.0% that was recorded for the 2021/22 Fiscal year.

1.3.2 EAC Regional Energy, Fuel and Utilities Inflation

Prices of Energy, Fuel and Utilities (EFU) Product category as used to measure Non- Core Inflation are Electricity, Natural gas; Liquefied hydrocarbons, Liquid fuels, Coal, Coal briquettes, Peat, Wood fuel including pellets and briquettes; Charcoal, Other solid fuels, and Other energy for heating and cooling. Thus, Inflation under this category measures price changes of the above¬ listed product categories.



The Annual Energy, Fuel and Utilities Inflation in the EAC Region as measured by the EAC-HCPI stood at 13.2% in December 2023. A year earlier, in December 2022, the rate was 12.5% (Table 1.4)

The month-on-month Energy, Fuel and Utilities Inflation stood at 0.4% in December 2023, down from 0.7% which was registered in November 2023. It was 1.1% in December 2022.



The Annual Average Energy, Fuel and Utilities Inflation in 2023

The Annual Average Energy, Fuel and Utilities Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the EAC-HCPI was 11.7% for 2023 Calendar year up from 8.6% recorded for 2022 Calendar year. It was 11.8% for 2022/23 Fiscal Year up from 6.9% that was recorded for 2021/22 Fiscal year.



1.4 EAC Regional Food Inflation

Food products refers to Food Group of COICOP-2018 Classification.

The month-on-month Food Inflation stood at minus 1.3% in December 2023, down from 0.2 % which was registered in November 2023. It was minus 3.5 % in December 2022 (Table 1.7).



The Annual Average Food Inflation in the EAC region was at 6.4% for the 2023 calendar year down from 7.6% recorded for the 2022 Calendar year while it was 9.1% for 2022/23 Fiscal Year up from 6.6% that was recorded for 2021/22 Fiscal year.

1.5 EAC Regional Non Food Inflation

Non-Food products excludes the Food Group products as classified by COICOP-2018.

The Annual Non-Food Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the EAC-HCPI was 5.2% in December 2023 down from 5.9% registered in November 2023, it was 6.5% in December 2022.

The month-on-month Non-Food Inflation stood at 0.1% for the month of December 2023.lt was the same rate of 0.1% registered in November 2023. It was 0.8% in December 2022.

The Annual Average Non-Food Inflation in the EAC region as measured by the EAC- HCPI was 6.3% for the 2023 Calendar Year up from 4.4% recorded for 2022 Calendar year.



The annual average Non-Food Inflation for 2022/23 Fiscal Year was 6.2% up from 2.9% that was recorded for 2021/22.


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2. INTERNATIONAL MERCHANDISE TRADE

2.1 Regional Total Trade

The EAC region's total trade value with the rest of the world (ROW) in the 4th quarter of 2023 (October to December 2023) was US\$ 20.9 billion, which was a 7% increase compared to US\$ 19.6 billion in the similar quarter of 2022.

The region's imports from ROW were US\$ 14.3 billion in 2023 Q4 compared to US\$ 13.4 billion in 2022 Q4, equivalent to a 6% increase

With regards to total exports, the region exported goods worth US\$ 6.7 billion in 2023 Q4 from US\$ 6.1 billion in 2022 Q2, equivalent to a 9% increase.

Overall, the region is a net importer recording a negative trade balance of US\$ 7.6 billion in 2023 Q4. Compared with a similar period in 2022, the trade balance worsened by 4% from US\$ 7.2 billion.

The region's total trade with Africa 14% continent increased by 14% in Q4 2023 compared to Q4 2022 with value of trade worth US\$ 4.8 billion transacted, representing 23.3 percent of total trade (Table 2.2).

The intra-EAC trade was second with trade valued at US\$ 2.8 billion, accounting for 13.8% in 2023 Q4 having increased from 13.2% in the same period last year.



Trade with COMESA and SADC accounted for 11.5% and 12.9 % respectively during the 2023 Q4 period.



The total trade by country indicates China, United Arab Emirates and India have remained the top three EAC trading partners recording a trade valued at US\$ 8.8 billion or 42% of total trade in 2023 Q4



The top five most traded products by HS Section account for 64.6 percent of the total trade value at US\$ 13.5 billion in 2023 Q3 compared to 65.7 percent in 2022 Q3.




2.2 Performance of Exports



Total exports from the EAC region have remained stable. The total export during the last quarter of 2023 amounted to US\$ 6.7 billion, equivalent to a growth of 8.6% compared to similar period in 2022

The ten items exported in 2023 Q4 account for 57.4% of the total exports comprising mainly of Precious and semi-precious stones (nonmonetary gold) – 25.1%; Mineral fuel (mainly crude oil from the Republic of South Sudan) and petroleum products (re-exports) – 12.9%; Coffee and tea – 10.4%; and Dried leguminous vegetables – 2.5%; and Unmanufactured Tobacco – 2.2%





to US\$ 1,556.8 million, reflecting a decline of 3.5%.










The value of imported goods into the region in 2023 Q4 was US\$ 14.3 billion from US\$ 13.4 billion recorded in 2022

Uganda's imports from the region were the largest at 46.8% followed respectively by Rwanda (27.8%), Kenya (10.3%), Tanzania (8.6%), Burundi at 4.9% and South Sudan (1.5%).
