

**THE EAST AFRICAN COMMUNITY CUSTOMS
MANAGEMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2011**

**An Act of the Community to amend the East African
Community Customs Management Act, 2004**

ENACTED by the East African Community and assented to
by the Heads of State.

1. This Act may be cited as the East African Community Short title
Customs Management (Amendment) Act, 2011.

2. Section 112 (2) of the East African Community Amendment
of section
112
Customs Management Act, 2004 is amended by substituting
for that subsection, the following new subsection—

“(2) Preferential Tariff treatment shall be applied
to goods referred to in subsection (1)(a) up to the 31st
December, 2012”.
